Adnan Z. Amin, a Kenyan national, is an economist specialising in environment and sustainable development. He has worked extensively on development issues, initially at the Institute of Development Studies of the University of Sussex in the United Kingdom and at the World Bank. He has been with the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) for nearly 15 years, in several capacities, including having been in charge of a programme on environmental institution building in developing countries, and UNEP=s unit for environmental policy coordination and collaboration with other United Nations entities. He was appointed Director of UNEP=s Office at UN Headquarters in New York in late 1997, with responsibility for policy coordination and development, liaison between the United Nations in New York and UNEP=s headquarters in Nairobi, and to work for and on behalf of UNEP with the private sector and other civil society groups at UN Headquarters and within the North American region. He has played a key role in redefining UNEP=s coordination structure following the 1992 Earth Summit and in setting its priorities in light of the outcomes of the 2002 World Summit on Sustainable Development.
